## Community

Makua Lani, Hawaiian for Heavenly Father and nestled on the tropical slopes of Hualalai Mountain with a panoramic view of the Pacific Ocean, is located in the vicinity of Kailua-Kona on the Big Island of Hawaii. The school's goal for its 9th - 12th grade students is to develop a strong, mature personal relationship with Jesus Christ, to become a fulfilled and well-adjusted individual, and to be a Biblically based thinker who can effectively interpret his/her role in society. The student body is culturally diverse with a population that is 38% Caucasian, 25% Pacific Islander, 19% Asian, 15% Hispanic, and 3% African American.

### **School**

Makua Lani Christian Academy is a comprehensive four-year private school enrolling 98 students in grades 9–12. The school opened in the fall of 1992 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 1993. Makua Lani Christian Academy is accredited by the **Western Association of Schools & Colleges (WASC) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI)** and holds membership in the **College Board** and the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools (HAIS).

### Curriculum

The **academic program** is on a traditional six period day. Three credits per semester is the maximum course load with additional outside credits available through online classes, sports and drama programs.

The following AP® courses are offered on a rotating basis: AP Language and Composition, AP Literature and Composition, AP Calculus, AP Art, AP US History, AP World History, and AP European History, and AP Government and Politics.

Honors classes are offered in Literature, History, Science and Math.

#### Rank

Student ranking is based on cumulative grade point average including grades 9, 10 & 11. Class ranking is updated in January and June.

### **Grade Point Average (GPA) Calculation**

GPA is computed using the above quality points. Beginning with grade nine, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. A minimum of 25 credits is **required for graduation**. **AP classes are weighted by one point**. Grades are recorded on the transcript and GPA is computed in January and June.
